PERIEGESIS project is aiming to promote inclusiveness of Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) people in vaults of cultural treasures; mainly museums, galleries, and similar cultural spaces. We planning to do it by elevating the skills of hearing museum and/or gallery staff such as Docents, Public relations Officers, Museum Shop Managers, Museum Protection Staff, Tour guides etc, to be able to communicate with DHH. PERIEGESIS is also aiming to bring closer the cultural places to DHH.
